Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2014-15 educational progress for the Centreville Public Schools District and our schools. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and some requirements of state laws. Our staff is available to help you understand this information. Please contact Robert Kuhlman, Superintendent, for help if you need assistance.

The DISTRICT AER is available for you to review electronically by visiting the following web site www.cpschools.org or you may review a copy in the main office at your child's school. Each school will also be communicating their own AER to parents directly.

These reports contain the following information:

Student Assessment Data – Elementary or middle school assessment results on the Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress (M-STEP), high school assessment results on the M-STEP component of the Michigan Merit Exam (MME), and assessment results for students with disabilities on Michigan's Alternative Assessment Program (MI-Access).

- Presents achievement data for all four tested subjects (English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies) compared to targets for all students as well as subgroups of students
- Helps parents understand achievement progress within schools and compare these to district and state achievement

Accountability Scorecard – Detail Data and Status

Due to the transition from MEAP tests to the M-STEP test, the accountability portion of the AER is limited to assessment participation and graduation/attendance rates. Full accountability reporting will resume with the 2015-16 AER.

- **The Graduation Rate for Centreville Jr/Sr High School is 100%.**
- **The Graduation Rate for the District is 83.1%**
- **Our District Daily Attendance Rate is 94.5% .**

Teacher Qualification Data

- Identifies teacher qualifications at district and school levels
- Reports percentage of core academic classes taught by teachers not considered highly qualified to teach such classes
- **All Centreville Public School teachers are Highly Qualified in their subject area.**

NAEP Data (National Assessment of Educational Progress)

- Provides state results of the national assessment in mathematics and reading every other year in grades 4 and 8. ***Please note that Centreville Public Schools was not selected to participate in NAPE Testing during the 2014-15 school year.***

We are proud of the accomplishments of our students during the 2014-15 school year. These accomplishments include the following:

- Members of the Class of 2015 scored above the state average on the ACT English, Reading, and Science Tests, as well as on the Composite Score.
- Members of the Class of 2015 were first in the county on the ACT Composite Score and on the English and Science Tests. They were second in the county in Mathematics and Reading.
- Members of the Class of 2015 scored above the state average on the ACT College Readiness scores for English, Reading, and Science.
- Members of the Class of 2015 were first in the county in College Readiness for English and Science. Students were second in the county in College Readiness in Reading and for the Composite ranking.
- This was the first year of Michigan's new Online M-Step Test. Centreville Public School students in grades 3-9 scored above the state average in Math Grade 4 and Grade 8, and in Social Studies Grade 8.

Our goal is to increase student learning and student achievement during the coming school year. The support of our parents and community is critical to our continued success. We look forward to working together for our students.
