We have received a significant amount of input from staff, parents, and community members regarding the Constitution Day Celebration on Friday, September 17, and our planned response. Due to this event, Main Street and some secondary roads off Main Street will be closed from 7:00 a.m. - 9:00 p.m. Please plan for additional time to get to and from school on Friday.

In response to all of the input we received, we have made the decision to hold a half-day of school on Friday. By doing so, families have the choice to attend the event if they wish. We believe that our school environment is safe, and our students should come to school on Friday to learn about our Constitution, something every school in Michigan will be doing.

Yesterday you received communication regarding our plans for maintaining a safe learning environment for students and staff. These precautions are being taken in an abundance of caution. There has been NO indication of an active security threat to the school. We will be working in collaboration with the St. Joseph County Sheriff's Department and if we find that our outlined safety precautions are not necessary, we will lift them and make you aware via School Messenger.

School will dismiss at 11:30 a.m. on Friday, with no additional school-sponsored activities after school. If your child is a walker, and you would like to request a ride home for them, please contact Ms. Green **no later than 9:30 a.m.** on Friday to make your request.
