Dear Bulldog Family:

First, and foremost, I would like to thank you for being patient with us as we are navigating uncharted space in education. The staff of Centreville Public Schools is as committed as ever to ensuring that we are able to work with you and your family for the remainder of the school year.

The week of April 3rd you filled out a survey for the district indicating how your student would prefer to receive learning opportunities for the remainder of the year. You selected one of the following options for each of your children.

- Option A, is to complete the work online (family has internet and device)
- Option B, is to complete the work online (family has internet, needs a device)
- Option C, is to complete the work with a paper packet.

As we roll out the remote learning format, we will need your help in getting your student set-up with whichever learning format you selected by April 16, 2020. Our plan is to begin instruction on April 20, 2020.

If you chose Option A, we ask that your child logs into google classroom beginning April 20, 2020 when instruction will begin.

If you chose Option B, we need you to come to school on April 16, 2020 to pick up their Chromebook. We are only able to provide one Chromebook per household for those who requested one. When you arrive at school you will pull up to the Jr. High half circle. Stay inside your car. A staff member will ask for your name and hand you a device and an Authorized User Agreement that you will be required to sign in order to take the device. We anticipate this process will take minutes. If you are unable to pick up your device, we will make arrangements to drop the device off to your home on Friday, April 17, 2020 between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

If you chose Option C, you will need to come to school on April 16, 2020, and April 30th to pick-up your child's packet between 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.. You will pull up to the Jr. High half circle. Stay inside of your car. A staff member will ask you for your child's name and will hand you their packet. If you are unable to pick-up your packet we will make arrangements to drop off the packet to your home on Friday, April 17, 2020 between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.


***All Young 5's-2nd Grade will be given paper packets regardless of which option was selected on April 16th**
