- **A scheduled pick-up of food on:**
 - **Thursday, March 19 from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm**
 - **Thursday, March 26 from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm.**

Food may be picked-up in the high school parking lot at the end of Nottawa Street, near the high school office entrance.

At each of the pick-ups, we will provide parents with 9 breakfasts and 9 lunches per child. Children need not be present at the pick-up.
