Dear Centreville Public Schools Staff and Families:

We received news yesterday afternoon, shortly before dismissal, of three confirmed positive COVID-19 cases. Administration immediately implemented our contact tracing plan to identify people who were in direct contact with these individuals. Direct contact is defined as being within six feet of a person with a confirmed case for more than fifteen minutes.

We have consulted with the local health department regarding the identification of close contacts. Contact tracing is the key to quickly identifying and isolating those people affected so we can safely continue to hold in-person classes. Parents of the students, and staff that have been in close contact with COVID-19 individuals, have been notified that they must quarantine at home for 14 days to watch for symptoms.


We have thoroughly prepared for multiple scenarios and are ready to take the necessary steps for the safety and health concerns of our students, staff, and community, while meeting the recommendations of the Center for Disease Control and our local health department.

We will continue to be diligent in all our efforts to keep students and staff safe while keeping our schools open for in-person instruction. The safety measures include daily health checks; required facial coverings; social distancing, when possible; frequent handwashing; sanitizing and disinfecting common touch areas; and daily facility/bus cleaning and disinfecting.
