Dear Centreville Public Schools Staff and Families:

This letter is to notify you that we currently have one confirmed positive COVID-19 case within the district. Upon hearing of this confirmed case, administration immediately implemented our contact tracing plan to identify people who were in direct contact with this individual. Direct contact is defined as being within six feet of a person with a confirmed case for more than fifteen minutes.

We have consulted with the local health department regarding the identification of close contacts. Contact tracing is the key to quickly identifying and isolating those people affected so we can safely continue to hold in-person classes. Those who have been in close contact with the individual have been notified that they must quarantine at home for 10 days to watch for symptoms.

We will continue to be diligent in all our efforts to keep students and staff safe while keeping our schools open for in-person instruction. The safety measures include daily health checks; required facial coverings; social distancing, when possible; frequent handwashing; sanitizing and disinfecting common touch areas; and daily facility/bus cleaning and disinfecting.

This notification has been posted on our district website at www.cpschools.org. You will also find our district dashboard on our website. The district dashboard is updated regularly with information about the number of staff and students quarantined.
