Parents/Guardians of Centreville Elementary School students:

Yesterday evening a decision was reached to pause in-person learning beginning Wednesday, October 27th through Friday, October 29th due to widespread illness of students and staff. During these times teachers will continue to deliver instruction virtually and students should plan to be present remotely for their classes.

Students will need to log into their school issued device via Google classroom. Teachers spent today preparing students for what to expect and transitioning lesson plans to accommodate remote learning. The schedule will be the same as your child's regular schedule, with virtual classes beginning promptly at 7:52 and ending at 2:59. If you cannot access the internet from home, a list of internet hot spots will be posted on the school website.

Our Storybook Character parade originally scheduled for Friday has been re-scheduled to Monday November 1st at 9 a.m. Parents are welcome to stand outside the building to watch the parade. Bulldog Boogie will also be rescheduled at a date to be determined. We will send that information as soon as we have the new date.

Our food service department will provide a drive-thru meal pick-up on Wednesday from 2-4 p.m. near the jr/sr high school office. During that time, food packages will be available for each student in your family.
