Parents/Guardians of Centreville Jr./Sr. High School students:

Yesterday evening a decision was reached to pause in-person learning beginning Wednesday, October 27th through Friday, October 29th due to widespread illness of students and staff. During this time teachers will continue to deliver instruction virtually and students should plan to be present remotely for their classes.

Students will need to log into their school issued device via Google classroom. Teachers spent today preparing students for what to expect and transitioning lesson plans to accommodate remote learning. Below is the student schedule during the remote learning school days this week:

During our virtual schedule *all* students, junior high and high school, will take part in Enrichment and a lunch break at the same time. This is the only change from our in-person schedule and is intended to minimize any confusion for families with students in multiple grade levels. Students have three minutes between classes as they would during a regular school day. Attendance will be taken for all classes and Enrichment during the virtual days.

Our food service department will provide a drive-thru meal pick-up on Wednesday from 2-4 p.m. near the jr/sr high school office. During that time, food packages will be available for each student in your family.
